Scope:

- The IMPPA Scholarship will be awarded annually in the amount of up to \$1,000.00.
- This scholarship is available to anyone with connections to IMPPA members (sponsor).
- This scholarship is not limited to a course of study in meat science or equivalent.
- This scholarship can be used at any accredited school for further education.
- The scholarship is a one-time award.

Scholarship Selection Criteria:

- Applications will be by provided document.
- Applications are due by date as stated.
- Age, gender, religion, or national origin are not conditions of eligibility for this scholarship.

Scholarship Selection Process:

1. The IMPPA Scholarship Committee will consist of a minimum of three (3) IMPPA members as selected by the IMPPA Board of Directors.
2. The committee will review and evaluate the application and all criteria. A weighted criteria evaluation may be utilized.
3. The committee will forward recommendations to the IMPPA Board of Directors for final approval of the award.
4. The scholarship recipient(s) will be announced at the annual IMPPA Convention.
